



### DID YOU KNOW ....



In today's Gospel Jesus reiterates the first commandment from the book of Deuteronomy, concerning the love for God, as being the first commandment of all, and also the second, found in Leviticus 19:18, concerning the love for our brothers and sisters, as being the second

most important commandment.

Jesus links the two commandments in the sense that we have to love God in order to be able to love our fellow human beings. Likewise, one can't claim to love God without making that visible in human relations. This was, and still is, the way of life for Jesus' followers.

In this spirit St. Augustine emphasized that authentic charity is the only way a society can survive in peace and well-being. He points out that when people seek their own way without regard to others, there will always be conflict, fear and suffering.

St. Thomas Aquinas points out that the theological virtues of faith, hope and love are those which enable us to live in a relationship with God, and this relationship then animates all other faculties needed for a loving relationship with other human beings.
