The Third Sunday of Advent is often called Gaudete Sunday.

This Sunday marks a shift in the Advent season from a period of penance to one of joy as we draw closer to the celebration of Christmas.

The priest may wear rose-colored vestments on this day, symbolizing joy and hope. This is a visual reminder of the joy that comes with the nearing of Christmas.

The readings often reflect on John the Baptist, who bears witness to Christ. His call to conversion and preparation for the coming of the Messiah is central to the Advent message.
